

Conditions of Play Ham and Turkey Carnival 2019

- The game will be played in accordance with the laws of the Game of Lawn Bowls. (Crystal Mark 3rd Edition).
- 2 There will be two games of 13 ends.
- 3 One trial end before each game. In Game 2, Skips can agree to waive the trial end.
- There will be no dead ends. Jack is to be re-spotted on the "T".
- 5 In the case of a draw there will be no additional ends.
- The winning skip to return both cards at the end of each game to the Match Coordinator.
- 7 There will be prizes for the Overall Winner, Overall Runner up, and winner of each game and random prizes.
- Scoring is 3 points for each game won, 1 ½ points for a drawn game, and 1 point for each end won.
- The Overall Winner and Runner-up will be the teams with the most wins and the highest total points over the two games. If there is still a tie, the winner will be decided by the highest overall margin, then by the highest overall score.
- 10 The winner of each game will be scored as above.
- 11 No player may win more than one prize.
